

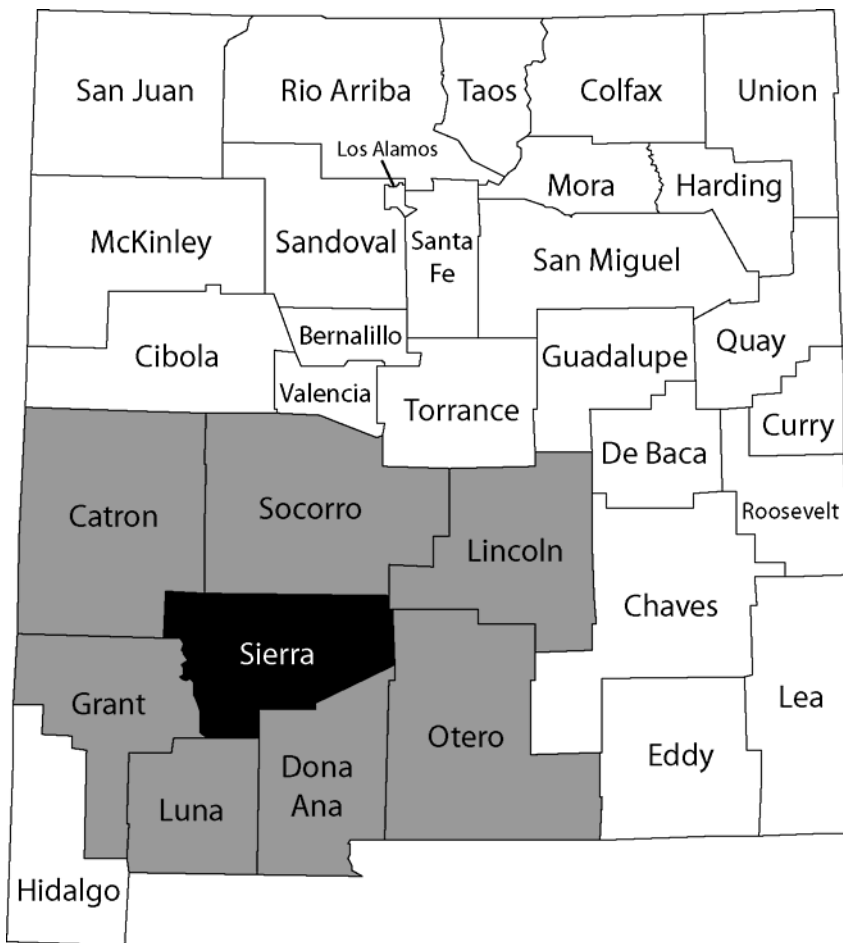

CALL FOR PAPERS

The 63rd annual Fall Field Conference of the New Mexico Geological Society will be held in Sierra County and hosted out of Truth or Consequences. The conference area is in a geologically diverse portion of the center of the state that has not been formally visited by the Society since 1986. The trip offers the opportunity to observe all aspects of the local geology, including Rio Grande rift tectonics and sedimentary history; Paleozoic stratigraphy, sedimentation and paleontology; geology of the Caballo and Mud Springs Mountains; and Tertiary volcanism and mining history in the southern San Mateo Mountains.



Authors are asked to inform the organizers if they want to submit a manuscript and/or mini-paper to the Guidebook co-editor listed below on or before **December 31, 2011** by e-mail or letter. Articles on any aspect of the geology of Sierra County as well as immediately adjoining counties (see map) are appropriate. The intent to submit should include (1) proposed manuscript title and authorship; (2) estimated number of double-spaced manuscript pages; and (3) estimated number of figures. Mini-papers are encouraged and will be limited to 1500 words and one figure. Details of manuscript preparation and format will be provided to authors who submit titles and are also available at:
