Open Meeting:

- 1. Scott Baldridge called the meeting to order at 9:13am
- 2. Adam Read reported on the webmaster updates. Uploaded photos from Mt. Taylor conference.
- 3. Added a vaccine status portion for the Socorro trip online. We need to decide on our hardline position on vaccine status.
- Publications committee report (Dave Lemke)- sales are down. Applied for cross ref. Mentioned digitizing older guidebooks. This might be a winter project. Some guidebooks might need to be rescanned.
- 5. Fall field conference- Mt. Taylor FFC budget review (Bonnie Frey and Kevin Hobbs)- had a few dropouts. Budget slightly in the red. See Attachment 4. Have a refund date which is usually before the order to the caterer is submitted. After that, no refund is given.
- 6. Fall field conference- Socorro (Dan Koning). Guidebook is going well. Working on layout. Scheduled to be submitted for printing at Starline on July 11. Book is 425 pages. Discussed having a meeting to approve the budget in July. Decided on July 11 at 1pm Mountain time. Registration will be open on August 8. How do we want to handle vaccines and wearing masks? Will stick with what was done for Mt. Taylor. Plan to have 130 participants.
- 7. Fall field conference- southeast NM (Lewis Land). Lewis and Kate Ziegler met recently for planning. Plan to have the accommodation at Washington Ranch. They have bunk houses and people can camp. All the meals will be included. The ranch has limited RV spaces. Lewis will confirm number of beds

available, but currently he has 89 beds written down. Lewis plans to cap the attendance to 129 people based on available beds and tent camping space.


The NMGS website has automated News, Events, and Announcements functions. If there is anything new that should be posted, please let me know. It is also possible for EC members, with permission, to create
