**CALL FOR PAPERS**

The 59<sup>th</sup> Fall Field Conference of the New Mexico Geological Society will be held in the Silver City area of southwestern New Mexico. The conference will focus on the wide variety of geology in the region, including Precambrian metamorphic and granitic rocks, Paleozoic carbonate rocks, middle Cenozoic volcanic rocks, and the upper Cenozoic Gila Conglomerate. The general chairman and guidebook editors for the conference are Greg Mack and Jim Witcher.

Authors are asked to provide an intent to submit a paper and/or mini-paper via email, phone, or letter to Greg Mack prior to December 20. The intent to submit should include proposed title and authors and estimated number of pages and figures. Authors are asked to limit papers to 20 pages (double spaced). Longer papers will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Authors will be required to secure two external reviews for each paper and should submit those reviews with the final manuscript. The deadline for final submission of papers to Greg Mack is March 15, 2008. Mini-papers should be limited to 1500 words and one figure and will be reviewed by the guidebook editors. Deadline for final submission of mini-papers to Greg Mack is January 20, 2008. Papers and mini-papers may be submitted by email or on a CD.
